*** Scarcity of unheated rubies leads to undersupply of the market:

Over the last couple of years, most of the traditional supplier countries of ruby (e.g. Burma, Thailand/Cambodia) have experienced a significant drop in their production of high-quality ruby. Other producers of rubies, such as Madagascar, Kenya, Tanzania, Vietnam, Afghanistan and Tajikistan could also not satisfy the demand for top-quality stones. The resulting undersupply, especially of large natural (i.e. unheated) rubies, led to rising carat-prices for unheated rubies of almost any geographic origin.

*** Gubelin Lab boosts investments in analytical instruments:

The Gubelin Gem Lab is permanently modernising and upgrading its level of sophisticated analytical instruments, to provide an even higher level of analysis both in Lucerne and while performing Off-Premise-Testings abroad. Among other investments, a significant step ahead is the acquisition of a Laser-Ablation Inductively-Coupled Plasma Mass Spectrometer (LA-ICP-MS) for the laboratory in Lucerne. This cutting edge analytical tool further distinguishes the quality and competence of both research work and client services at the Gubelin Gem Lab.

*** Lucerne inaugurates portrait of Dr. Eduard Gubelin in its gallery of distinguished citizens: The portrait gallery of Lucerne unifies paintings of important local personalities, who have earned a distinguished reputation in the region and abroad.
